'Shiatsu is a profound therapy that when applied correctly, gets to the root cause of the animal's problem quickly and effectively within three sessions,' says Jacqueline. 'To think of it as a nice ongoing treat for a pet is lovely, but if the Practitioner doesn't alleviate the problem you initially started with within the three sessions, the cost to the owner soon mounts up and the poor results from the practitioner weakens the reputation and trust in the therapy.'

'There are obviously some extreme cases that are very serious and can be an exception to this golden rule, but again, if you see no really significant changes within three sessions Jacqueline would strongly advise that the owner or practitioner contact her to discuss what she would recommend from this point on.'
